David Williamson's latest play 'INFLUENCE' directed by Kim Martin

As far as we know this will be the first W.A. production of this play which broke all box office records for the Sydney Opera House Drama Theatre when first produced in 2005. The title comes from the influence wielded by radio shock jocks such as Alan Jones and John Laws.

SYNOPSIS:

Ziggi Blasko knows how to turn fear into hate. A talkback radio host with " commonsense " answers, he likes to push buttons. His diatribes against political correctness, feminism,multiculturalism, immigration and bleeding hearts flood the airwaves and the scary part is that people listen. At home however, his influence isn't so great- his new wife Carmela is too narcissistic to listen much, his daughter Vivienne (by his first marriage) is a manic depressive, his Croation father Marko has a secret that could destroy Ziggi's career, and his sister Connie is a psychologist with opinions and solutions a world away from Ziggi's. When the new turkish housekeeper, Zehra (with a moral core diametrically opposed to Ziggi), enters the fray, the simplistic contradictions of Ziggi's world views look set to implode in this satire from Australia's most popular playwright.

CAST:

Ziggi - late 40's- early 50's
Carmela (his trophy wife - trying to revive a somewhat mediocre ballet career) – late 20's to early 30's
Vivienne (his daughter) - 17
Connie (his sister) - late 40's
Marko (his father) - about 80
Zehra (the housekeeper) - late 30's to early 40's
Tony (the driver) - late 30's to early 40's



The ages can be a little flexible if necessary.

Kim does have some scripts available so ring him if you want to have a look or if you want to ask any other questions about the play, characters or production.

Rehearsals will begin in March. At this stage, production dates are May 20, 21, 25, 27, 28 2011.3

A lot of changes have taken place this year to the Theatre. The City of Armadale have implemented a regime to bring us up to date with our O.H.S. All of the electrics have been made safe, as all power circuits are now R.C.D protected as well as new emergency lighting, exits signs and security lighting fitted outdoors. All of our exit doors have had new push bars fitted and now open outwards.

The men's toilets have had a freshen up, & new carpet has been fitted to the foyer. We are still waiting on the new vinyl to be fitted to the kiosk & toilet passages. This should take place very soon. We have obtained Quotes on a Patio to be installed at the side of the theatre & we will be coming to a decision about this soon.

My thanks go out to all of our members who have helped to make this another good year. Without your support & help we couldn't run our Theatre. As you know it's all on a voluntary basis & I know that life is busy. So its extra special that you all pitch in and help when needed.



Improvements

The improvements to our Theatre are still ongoing. The City of Armadale have just completed a retaining wall (See Picture) to the steps from the Cast Car Park. My thanks to Sherrill Wallis & Kim Fletcher for helping me with this project.

We have just employed a tree removalist to do some much needed work around the Theatre Grounds. There is a large tree branch overhanging one of the bays in the car park & has to be made safe. The dreaded Jacaranda is going to be removed & a new one planted in another position of the garden as well as other numerous jobs.

The auditorium roof is in poor condition due to age (see picture). The City of Armadale have allocated a sum of \$11,451.00 to have this replaced. I am still negotiating a time when this can be replaced. Hopefully this can be completed before the commencement of our 2011 season.
