We had an eventful time at the Theatre last month. One of our Fluorescent lights in the auditorium decided to catch fire during a rehearsal. Thankfully this was extinguished with hardly any damage done to the ceiling. We have since replaced all of the lighting in that area, since all of the fittings were of the same age. The City of Armadale have been very helpful in supplying the Electricians to install the new lighting. I also reported the loose wall sheeting around the Theatre & this has also been rectified by the council. It is encouraging to have the council responding to our needs, when we need them.

I also have engaged workers to repair some of the plastering in the Men's toilet. We will now get the tiles cleaned & re grouted before we give this area a much needed paint job. The men's toilet was desperately in need of repair, and is due for a makeover.

Many thanks to all, who helped with our stand at the Minnawarra Festival. We try to have a stand each year to promote the Theatre and its performances. We have been fortunate to secure new sponsorship for the Theatre. Bendigo Bank & Rob Fidock Real Estate have decided to come on board this year.
