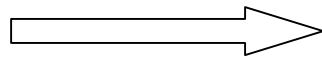

## President's Report

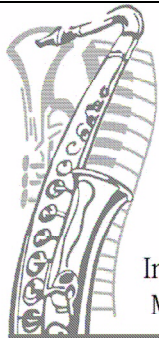

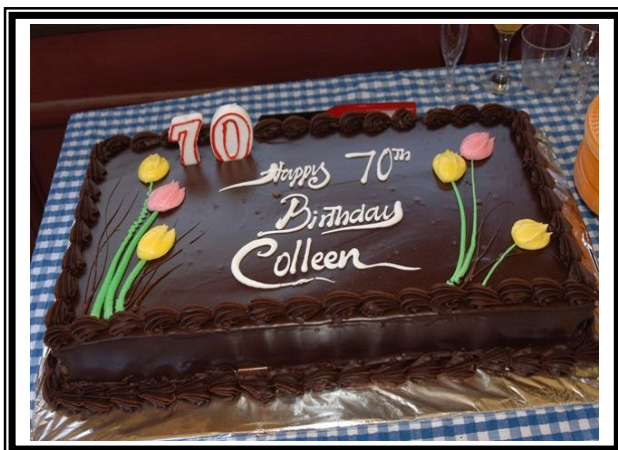
## Advance notice...
