AUDITIONS FOR THE MYSTERY OF EDWIN DROOD.

Directed by Priscilla Busher, with Musical Direction by Matt Austin

Auditions on the 5th and 6th of January. (Show on in May)

The Mystery of Edwin Drood is a musical (by Rupert Holmes - famous for the 'pina colada' song), which is based on the unfinished novel by Charles Dickens of the same name. This wildly warmhearted theatrical experience kicks off when the Music Hall Royale (a Victorian musical troupe)"puts on" its rendition of the unfinished Dickens mystery. The story itself deals with John Jasper, a Jekyll-and-Hyde choirmaster who is madly in love with his music student, Miss Rosa Bud, who in turn is engaged to Jasper's nephew, the young Edwin Drood. When Drood disappears one Christmas Eve, suspicions arise: Was Edwin Drood murdered? If so, then whodunit?

Decades before *Australian Idol, The Mystery of Edwin Drood* puts the audience in the driver's seat: when they vote on the murderer, they choose the ending performed each night!





Scott and Sonja Burns would like to introduce you to their bouncing baby boy...

The 33rd Annual ITA Finley Awards Ceremony

The Independent Theatre Association of WA is proud to present community theatre's 'Oscars' in recognition of amateur theatre's adjudicated productions for 2007. The 33rd Annual ITA Finley Awards Ceremony will be held on Saturday January 19, 2008 at the Lady Wardle Performing Arts Centre in Karrinyup.

Four dedicated ITA adjudicators attend every production entered throughout the year both in metropolitan and regional Western Australia. This year the competition is fierce with 54 productions entered, of those 42 are plays and 12 musicals competing for their clubs, hoping to return home with their heads proud carrying the honourable Finley.

From its humble beginnings in 1975 the Finley Awards have grown into one of the most prestigious events on the community theatre calendar. Comedians *Luke and Wyatt* will host the glamourous evening where entertainment will abound the large auditorium. *Luke and Wyatt* are a musical comedy duo based in Perth who have supported international touring acts such as Greg Fleet, Dave Callan, Dave Williams, and Dan Willis. They supported Tim Minchin in the 2006 Perth International Arts Festival, won Perth's musical comedy competition, "Acoustic Idol", and recently played at the 06/07 Falls Festival in Marion Bay, Tasmania. They can also be heard on RTR 92.1FM on Monday mornings on the "The Luke & Wyatt Variety Hour", hosted by Peter Barr.

Last year's Finley Award for Best Play was awarded to *Judas Kiss* and the Finley Award for Best Musical was awarded to *Seussical the Musical*, both productions presented by Playlovers in Floreat.

With entertainment from some of the best productions seen in 2007 and an electric atmosphere, if you have ever patronised a community theatre production or have been curious, then don't miss this night of nights.
