Into the Woods is a musical debuted in San Diego at the Old Globe Theatre in 1986, and premiered on Broadway in 1987. The musical intertwines the plots of several Brothers Grimm fairy tales and follows them further to explore the consequences of the characters' wishes and quests. The main characters are taken from the stories of Little Red Riding Hood, Jack and the Beanstalk, Rapunzel, and Cinderella, all tied together by an original story involving a Baker, his wife, and their quest to begin a family.

Nine is a musical based on an adaptation of Federico Fellini's autobiographical film 8½. It focuses on film director Guido Contini, savoring his most recent and greatest success. He is, however, facing his fortieth birthday along with a midlife crisis blocking his creative impulses and entangling him in a web of romantic difficulties in early-1960s Venice.

The original Broadway production won five Tony Awards, including best musical, and has enjoyed a number of revivals.

Nine has recently been made into an American musical film, directed by Rob Marshall. The film is scheduled to be released worldwide on December 25, 2009. The principal movie cast consists of Academy Award winners Daniel Day-Lewis, Nicole Kidman, Marion Cotillard, Penélope Cruz, Judi Dench and Sophia Loren, with Golden Globe Award winner Kate Hudson and Grammy Award winner Fergie in small supporting roles.


