A busy year with many successes! The year opened with 'Boston Marriage' and this was critically acclaimed and had an excellent cast and production crew under the guidance of Elliot McCann. Next was the classic 'Much Ado about Nothing' in which a large range of ages and experience levels graced the stage and brought the Bard to life under the direction of Paul Treasure. Truly a show for everyone. Then Stephen Lee brought his production of 'Blithe Sprit' to be staged in conjunction with the Roleystone Theatre (our role was to supply the 'theatre' and the crew) and this proved to be a happy working relationship for all. Finally at the end of the year we have had the hugely successful Avenue Q. There was some doubt about the appropriateness of this production however the feedback from all ages has been positive and indeed glowing. Full houses and laugh out loud performances made it a crowd pleaser.

The current line up of shows for 2013 has altered slightly as we were unable to secure the rights to 'The Trip to Bountiful'. This is a terrible shame and we are currently working to fill the gap.

There are a number of **social events** coming up in the near future; the Les Miserables Film Fundraiser on 16th January and the Sundowner and Awards Night on the 20th January. In addition the Finley Awards will be on Saturday 12th january 2013.
