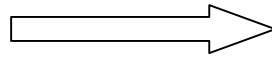

Our first social event of 2008, and the launch of our 75th Anniversary Year Celebrations, was a wine and cheese night held at the theatre on Saturday evening 12th January.

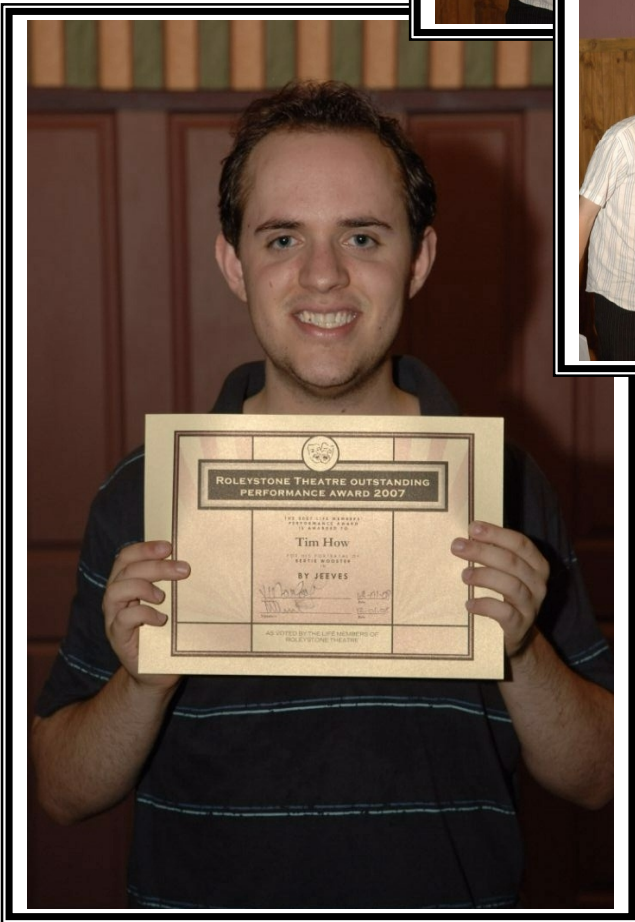
