There will be a discussion period when the electrical consultants report is finally ready.

On a sad note, one of our life members recently passed away. Joy Martin was involved with the theatre for many years not only as Secretary but a talented performer. Condolences to Graeme & family on your sad loss. Hope to see you all at the busy bee & the Finley Awards.


