I was shocked to discover that a window had been smashed to gain entry, Front Doors open, Bio door forced & drinks fridge in the kiosk area raided. The police did arrive some 10 minutes later, but who ever was there had departed the scene. It took about three hours for the emergency glazier to arrive and another hour to repair the damage. Next morning at 9.00am Neil from police forensic arrived to fingerprint the crime scene. It looks like he got some decent prints. Lets hope that the people responsible are apprehended soon. Its a horrible feeling when these sorts of things happen but we are fortunate that this does not happen often.

The new sign at the entrance to the Theatre has finally been installed. It looks great, and is double sided so you can't miss us going up or down the hill. There is still some work to be done on it and hopefully it will be completed to our satisfaction soon. My condolences go to Malita on her sudden loss of her mother, whom had only just arrived from the U.K. She was an amazing woman and was a great supporter of the Theatre. She will be sadly missed by all who new her.


End of Year Function
