President's Report

Hope you all had a Great Christmas & A Happy New Year to all. Isn't it fantastic news about a great number of our Performers & Directors being nominated for the Finley Awards. Of course anything can happen on the night, but we should at least pick up a couple of awards. We had some outstanding shows during 2009 & it would be fitting to be recognised for all the hard work & commitment. Tickets are still available, so please make an effort to come along & cheer our Theatre Members who have been nominated. It should be an outstanding Night.

<u>Our Annual General Meeting is coming up soon (February).</u> It would be pleasing to see most of our members attend, as we will be electing our Office Bearers for 2010. We need a strong committee to continue the work that has been achieved so far. We can't afford to rest on our laurels & must continue to further improve our facilities, so our cast and crews have the right tools to go about their work.

Into the Woods has commenced rehearsals already & Matt Austin has told me he has selected an amazing cast for this great show.

In December the Theatre had an inspection by three engineers to look at the structure of the building. This was commissioned by the City of Armadale. They did find some items that require attention. The roof on the auditorium needs to be replaced, as well as some of the timber cladding on the exterior due to rot. A tin roof generally has a life span of 25 years & I believe this was replaced in the sixties. So this is well over the use by date. The report has been sent to council & we shall see what happens from there. As you are all aware the electrical cable needs to be replaced in the auditorium, so hopefully this can be done at the same time as the roof.

A few months ago Gerry Chapman applied for a grant for monies for a Computer for the Bio Box as well as a cash register for the bar. We have had confirmation that we were successful in obtain \$2750.00 for this. Many Thanks Gerry for a fine effort. The computer & the cash register will be put to good use.

On a sadder note I lost my Father in Law on the 30th December. He attended a lot of shows at the Theatre & was amazed at the standard of acting, sets & costumes . He will be sadly missed by all his family


