We do have directorship guidelines that have the conditions that 'to direct a play you need have, as a minimum, successfully directed a one act play' and 'to direct a musical you need to have, as a minimum, successfully directed a full length play'.

Bar Overview

I thought I would give members the opportunity to see how the Theatre bar is organised in terms of people power:

Principal Approved Manager (P.A.M.) - Bree Hartley. Has completed a full liquor licensing course and accredited RSA certificate. This role carries the overall legal responsibility for the management of the bar, on behalf of the licensee (Roleystone Theatre Inc.).

Additional Approved Managers (A.A.M.) – Stephen Carr, Peter Woodstock and Kylie Grima. These people have done additional training to the accredited RSA to enable them to legally represent the licensee (the Roleystone Theatre Inc) in daily management of the bar.

Bar liaison (bar staff rosters and stock purchases) – Lys Tickner has taken on this role for 2010 to reduce the workload on the P.A.M.

Bar staff - anyone with a Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) certificate is able to staff the Theatre bar. If you would like to help in this area but don't have your RSA please contact Bree Hartley as the Theatre can cover your expenses.

Audition Requirements

Auditionees for lead roles must prepare two (2) songs, one of which MAY be from the show. Auditionees who are going for parts in the ensemble need only prepare 16 bars from a song. All auditionees must be prepared for a dance audition (not all characters will be required to dance) Due to the Felliniesque nature of the work, the production team will be open to considering any males who wish to audition for female roles.

Male Characters: Guido Contini, a film director (lead)

Guido at a young age (and 3 of Guido's schoolmates) all of whom are supposedly nine years old. We will be double casting the role of Young Guido, as a security measure just in case his voice breaks. The two actors cast as Young Guido will be expected to play one of Guido's school friends on the performances they are not playing Young Guido.

NOTE TO PARENTS: This show does contain some adult content and themes!

Female Characters: Luisa Contini, Guido's Wife (lead) Claudia, an actress (lead) Carla, Guido's mistress (lead) Lilliane Le Fleur, Guido's producer (lead) Stephanie Necrophorous, a critic (lead) Sarraghina, a whore (lead) Guido's Mother (lead) and about 15 other female characters

Note: There is no "chorus" in the show, all the characters in the ensemble are named and have the odd line here and there.

NOTE: The show contains sections of dialogue in French, German and Italian. We will have coaches available to help people who don't speak those languages, but knowing any of them is a plus
