He took the part of the villainous nephew in "Arsenic and Old Lace" and as one of the scenes opened he was sat on a lounge eating walnuts waiting for the entrance of his Aunties. Now Pauline knew approximately how many he should eat before their entrance so she knew that something wasn't right when he was eating more than usual. One of his fellow thespians who shall be nameless had had to take a toilet break and the stage manager raised the curtain to early. Bill solved that problem by asking "HAS ANYBODY SEEN THE AUNTIES?" He also played the part of the giant's voice off stage in "Jack and The Hasbeens."

Bill was an inspiration to everybody and especially our Junior Workshop members who he

encouraged in every possible way to give their best both on and off stage. In fact he became a Grandfather figure to a lot of the children.


He was a founding member of U3A Armadale and was President for a number of years; he was the instigator and leader of their History Group and made many friends through these organisations.

Plays: \$15 Adults and \$12 Children (17 years and under) Musicals: \$20 Adults and \$15 Children (17 years and under)

These prices reflect the demands on a production's budget whilst being in line with, or below, the ticket prices of other community theatres in Perth.
