The Embankment Stabilisation

After the completion of the Earth Stabilisation by the Council last month, some damage to the ground had occurred by the heavy machinery during the process. I reported this to the Council and thought that they would just patch the holes. It was a complete surprise to see that they have completely resurfaced the entire area with bitumen. It looks fantastic (See Pictures). The concreting of the steps should commence this week & I will report this to you in the next "Call Boy". I have spoken to the council about adding a colour to the concrete as not to make the Steps too obvious & they have agreed to this. I am anxious to see all of these projects completed before the winter sets in. Regards, Zyg


