RSA training:

To work behind any bar in W.A. you now need to have a Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) certificate. This involves completing either an online reading followed by questions or going along to a 'class' at a RSA provider. The purpose of the RSA learning is so that all bar staff have the same required knowledge about alcohol and minimising its potentially harmful effects.

We have a number of people that have RSA certificates in the Theatre, however I am finding it difficult to staff the bar for some performances due to availability of RSA certified members.

To this end we are seeking expressions of interest from any member who would like to undergo this (admittedly easy) training and assessment, paid for by the Theatre, so they can be available and certified to help out in the bar a night, or five, each year! This will occur within the next couple of months.
